Instructions

Secure your bur to the float using a "T" Wrench and Disk Wrench or Disk Pliers.



Attach cable securely to float.

If using a key drive cable and adaptor, follow the instructions included with your cable.

Apply grease to the grease port located on the side of the float head.

As you work, cool and clean your float in a bucket with water and Chlorhexidine. This will prolong the life of the tool.

Be sure to grease your float after every few horses, and again at the end of your work. This will help avoid rust buildup.
